Organization	The audience has difficulty following the presentation because there is no sequence of information; presenters go over or under the allotted time.	Presenters present information in mostly “logical” sequence which audience can follow; presenters nearly maintain the allotted time.	Presenters present information in logical, interesting, and engaging sequence which audience can follow; presenters maintain the allotted time.
Content and Knowledge	Presenters demonstrate a lapse in the understanding of their subject; presenters are uncomfortable fielding questions from the audience.	Presenters demonstrate some knowledge of the topics, but may lack insight; presenters show some hesitancy fielding questions from the audience.	Presenters demonstrate understanding of their topics; presenters demonstrate concepts with insight; presenters successfully field questions from the audience.
Delivery and Elocution	Presenters occasionally use eye contact, but still read mostly from slides/notes; presenters may be nervous or repeat gestures that distract from the presentation; audience may have difficulty hearing presenters.	Presenters maintain eye contact with audience as appropriate most of the time, but too often returning to slides/notes; presenters are somewhat natural in using gestures, voice, ...	Presenters maintain eye contact with audience as appropriate for their delivery and format; presenters seldom rely on notes and are natural, relaxed, yet well-prepared and practiced.
Collaboration and Creativity	Presenters lack creativity, seems unprepared; presenters demonstrate a lack of collaboration.	Presenters attempt to engage the audience in their subject, but may lack creativity; presenters attempt to work together, but may demonstrate a lack of preparation and balance.	Presenters engage the audience in their subject with creativity and intuition; presenters appear in synch, well-prepared, and balanced in a collaborative effort.
